

1st GCT TEAM ONLINE MEETING WITH EA GCT SUPPORT TEAM

Sunday, January 28, 2018

The Meeting was co-led by Roslyn Wanjiku and Liliane Ndabereye. The meeting gathered around 13 people for around 2 hours from 5:00-7:00 PM this Sunday Jan. 28th 2018:

- ✪ 10 from Burundi: Andre Butoyi, Brice Bakaza, Jean Marie, Vincent, Noe, Mariella G., Fridolin, Melisa, Augustin, Jean-Claude
- ✪ 2 from Nairobi: Roselyn and Liliane
- ✪ As well as Dorine (from Japan)

Major items discussed were:

- ✪ ***Reconnecting and sharing insights from God in the lives of the team members***
- ✪ ***Sharing the work of translation, editing and video productions for 3 coming Videos from Dr. Noel Woodroffe***

1. Insights from God in the lives of the team members

Roselyn took time to emphasize the divine facts that 2018:

- ◆ Is a new package / kit of time for us and nothing is random and thus no waste in our lives;
- ◆ Requires for us to ask critical questions: What is there for me? Based on my uniqueness? Who am I in God, by the way?
- ◆ Implies for us there is no more struggles with the “I don’t(s)” since it is packaged by God!
- ◆ Calls us to pray God to unlock us as DNW is praying; calls us also to do maintenance prayer
- ◆ Requires tracking and making Functional Maturity ours!
- ◆ Is a year for seeking the new highest levels of walking with the Holy Spirit under his leadership!

Liliane reminded participants:

- ◆ key principles for fostering that functional maturity: Sonship; Betsaleel factor for GCT members (we build around our leaders), the saints’ ownership of the movement (we can only move together & nothing is done without the saints)
- ◆ The easy-ness of the burden because it’s coming from the Lord Himself
- ◆ The promptness and accuracy of our actions: *“When God speaks, we move and we do!”* because *‘impossible is what we do’* as GCT!
- ◆ The primacy, once again; of the Holy Spirit

Among the interactions and insights that came from the participants, there were:

- ◆ The requirement for unity and togetherness
- ◆ The imperative of stillness to tap into the unlimited-ness of God through the Holy Spirit (John 15:1-15)
- ◆ The 1st thing is to abide in Him: *‘in Him all things hold together...’*

Roselyn concluded the sharing with 3 main guiding points from our C-WBN Regional Coordinator; Pastor Joseph Njoroge:

- ◆ *The purpose of one's calling: find the place of identity and calling!*
- ◆ *The power and resources needed for our functionality: no need to worry and struggle!*
- ◆ *The context of our functionality: the Apostolic Sphere; here there is enough grace!*
